WHEREAS, Joseph Young, Service Company H & S Battalion, Parris Island, South Carolina on Sunday, March 2, 1980, in disregard for his own safety, entered a burning house at 5910 Pleasant Farms Drive; and


WHEREAS, he and two companions gave the fire alarm and removed the occupants of the home from the fire; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the quick action of Mr. Young and his companions may have saved the lives of the occupants of the house including a six month old infant; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Beaufort County, that this action in thinking only of the inhabitants' safety and not of his own, is recognized by Beaufort County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appreciation of this action of heroism by Council on behalf of all our citizens is extended to him and he is honored as a member of our community.
