WHEREAS, the Technical Education System of South Carolina is pledged to training citizens of this state for jobs in business and industry.


WHEREAS, George W. Goldsmith, President of Beaufort Technical College, has declared Sunday, March 16, 1980 to be Open House Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, do hereby proclaim the week of March 9 through March 16, 1980; as:


