WHEREAS, the Phoenix Residential Community program will provide professional residential treatment for persons experiencing problems emanating from substance abuse and/or addiction; and

WHEREAS, the Phoenix Residential Community program, designed on a halfway house model, will seek to re-integrate these citizens into the mainstream of productive life, and


WHEREAS, the physical facilities and program of the Phoenix Residential Community represent a vital public asset worthy of attention and support for the valuable services it renders to the community at large; and
