WHEREAS, alcohol and other drug related traffic accidents and fatalities have become an increasing economic and social problem in our society, particularly to families where a member has been a victim; and

WHEREAS, the public, particularly through the work of citizens groups such as Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), is demanding a solution to the problem of driving under the influence; and

WHEREAS, citizens of Beaufort County should be made aware of the concern of the County for eliminating alcohol and drug related traffic incidences, accidents, and fatalities; and

WHEREAS, an increase in the County's awareness of the problem of driving under the influence may help to sustain current efforts to develop comprehensive solutions; and

WHEREAS, increased DUI enforcement efforts by law enforcement agencies for the detection and apprehension of persons driving under the influence would serve as a warning to keep such drivers off of our streets and highways; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Beaufort County should be made aware of the concern of County Council for eliminating alcohol and other drug related traffic incidences, accidents and fatalities; and

WHEREAS, an increase in the County's awareness of the problem of driving under the influence may help to sustain current efforts to develop comprehensive solutions;
