

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Lowcounty Council of Governments (LCOG) Board of Directors has authority to recommend State Transportation Improvement Projects (STIP) for Beaufort County; and

WHEREAS, there is \$7 million in funds available from cost under runs from STIP projects available for reallocation to other roadway construction and improvements projects in Beaufort County; and

WHEREAS, US 278 is a major thoroughfare in southern Beaufort County that carries extensive volumes of daily traffic both local and commuter and is the only roadway access to Hilton Head Island; and


WHEREAS, future traffic volume growth forecasts for southern Beaufort County will overwhelm the existing US 278 roadway; and

WHEREAS, Beaufort County currently has in progress active engineering design of widening projects for various locations on US 278.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Beaufort County Transportation Advisory Group recommends to the LCOG Board of Directors that the \$7 million in cost under runs from STIP projects be reallocated for the improvements needed to US 278.
