

1998 Goals

- Goal 1 Adopt a FY 98-99 budget with no increase in taxes for County operations.
- Goal 2 Complete the Comprehensive Plan and prepare the necessary ordinances to implement the Plan.
- Goal 3 Develop and adopt a plan to raise library holdings to State standards in ten years without reliance on property tax.
- Goal 4 Develop a plan for construction of a Hilton Head Airport control tower using federal financial assistance.
- Goal 5 Identify and establish consistent, long-term funding for the creation, improvement, and maintenance of boat landings.
- Goal 6 Attract 650 new professional, skilled and semi-skilled jobs paying higher wages to further the County's ongoing effort to diversify its economy and promote upward mobility for its citizens.
- Goal 7 Formulate a plan for financing construction and maintenance of a stormwater management system.
- Goal 8 Review fire district boundaries in an initiative to ultimately create a County Fire Department.
- Goal 9 Implement a County-wide recycling program that encompasses all municipalities.
- Goal 10 Establish further commonality in development standards between the County and its municipalities.
- Goal 11 Enter into an agreement with Jasper County for coordination of planning efforts and permanent respect of mutual boundaries.
- Goal 12 Hold quarterly meetings with County officials, municipal officials, and the Legislative Delegation to discuss intergovernmental issues.
- Goal 13 Conduct and support a public referendum on the local funding share for the widening of SC Highway 170 from the Career Education Center to the City of Beaufort.
