

RESOLUTION


Protection of Marine Resources and Water Quality

Per recent discussions with the Chairman of the Beaufort County Joint Planning Board, Mr. Fred Kuhn, Sr., concerns have been expressed regarding the protection of marine resources and water quality during the Comprehensive Plan preparation period. It is noted that such concern was voiced strongly during all recent public workshops for the Comprehensive Plan, and that water quality is among the chief issues for the Comprehensive Planning process.

It shall be the policy of the Beaufort County Council from hence forward to encourage the Joint Planning Board to fully exercise the authority granted by Section 4.13 of the Zoning and Development Standards Ordinance regarding the standards for the Planned Unit Development District in the enhanced protection of marine resources and water quality of waterbodies throughout the entire County. It is recognized that the County has the authority to negotiate standards pertinent to individual development projects through the Planned Unit Development provisions, and that environmental protection is a chief consideration under the existing standards.
